## National Incident Management System (NIMS) Training Requirements

All employees engaged in emergency related work, including temporary or administratively determined emergency hires, must meet the NIMS training requirements. There are four basic levels of personnel – see criteria below:

### 1.) Entry Level Personnel (mandatory for all)

IS-700.a: NIMS, An Introduction  
ICS-100: Introduction to ICS

### 2.) Single Resource Personnel, Non-Supervisory

IS-700.a: NIMS, An Introduction  
ICS-100, ICS-200: Basic ICS or its equivalent

### 3.) Team Leaders, Supervisors, Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Staff, etc.

IS-700.a: NIMS, An Introduction  
IS-800.b: National Response Framework, An Introduction  
ICS-100, ICS-200, and ICS-300 Intermediate ICS

#### **4.) Command and General Staff, Regional Emergency Coordinators, EOC Managers, etc.**

IS-700.a: NIMS, An Introduction

IS-800.b: National Response Framework, An Introduction

ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-300, and ICS-400 Advanced ICS

IS-700, IS-800, ICS-100, and ICS-200 are all self-study, “on-line” courses available from Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) on their Independent Study Website (<http://training.fema.gov/IS/crslist.asp>).
